ASSESS


- ❖ Continually monitor and evaluate RFAAP's environmental performance to ensure environmental compliance and effective operation of the Environmental Management System.

- ❖ Follow all applicable local, state, federal, U.S. Army, and internal environmental requirements and regulations.


TEAMWORK

- ❖ Educate employees and continually communicate our success and improvement plans.






